On 5 March, the European Commission organised a High-Level Conference in Brussels on ‘A new start for social dialogue’.

The conference was attended by Commission President Juncker, European Parliament President Schultz, Vice-President Dombrovskis, Commissioner Thyssen and on behalf of the Council Presidency, the Latvian Minister of Welfare Uldis Augulis .
